As we move into December and look towards the end of the year, I want to take a moment to reflect on the incredible spirit of community that defines Southern Chester County. This past month has been particularly inspiring, demonstrating the tangible impact we can achieve when we focus our collective energy on helping our neighbors.

One of the highlights of this period has been the amazing support for the HelpFeed ChesCo initiative. We are thrilled to announce that in one month,

\$208,476 was raised for the Chester County Food. This collective effort will make a profound difference to families facing food insecurity across Southern Chester County.

Beyond HelpFeed ChesCo, I also want to shine a light on the crucial work done through our food drive in the month of November. In partnership with KACS, Kennett Collaborative, and the Kennett Square Farmers Market, we were able to raise over a 1,000 pounds of food that went not only to KACS Food Pantry but also other local food pantries including SILO, Mighty Writers, and ONS. This is a powerful testament to the generosity of our community and the vital role that we as neighbors play in uplifting our community. Thank you to everyone who participated in these efforts, whether through monetary contributions, food donations, or volunteering your time.
