Dear Friends,

As we enter November, we recognize the very real challenges facing many of our neighbors. Recent funding delays and changes to essential state and federal assistance programs, particularly SNAP, have unfortunately increased the strain on families across Southern Chester County.

At the United Way of Southern Chester County, our mission is to ensure everyone has the opportunity to thrive, and that starts with food security. This is why we are mobilizing our efforts this month to address this critical community need.

We have joined forces with the Chester County United Way, the Chester County Community Foundation, and The Alliance for Health Equity. These four organizations have each committed \$25,000 to launch a collaborative relief effort, [HelpFeedChesCo](#). This incredible \$100,000 matching fund creates the potential for a total impact of \$200,000 for the Chester County Food Bank, maximizing community donations and benefits for local families.

We are proud to work with the Chester County Food Bank. This crucial partnership allows us to efficiently keep local pantries well-stocked with supplies. Our support is channeled directly to our community partners, including SILO, KACS, ONS, Mighty Writers, and others.
