## A Message from the CEO



Dear Friends,

When I am out in the community, I often hear people say, 'Darcie I do not see people on the streets and in need.' What many don't realize is our ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) households are hard at work, often with two jobs, to keep up with the rising cost of living. While their income is above the Federal Poverty Level, it's still not enough to cover the essentials.

In Chester County, 3 out of 10 households are struggling. And it's not just certain jobs. Across our

state, more than one third of workers in the 20 most common jobs – cashiers, cooks, janitors, delivery drivers – live in households that can't afford the basics and are forced to make sacrifices just to get breakfast and other meals on the table.

That's why we do what we do at United Way of Southern Chester Chester County. Our mission is to help ALICE families gain financial stability and to keep them from slipping into poverty over something as simple as a rising grocery bill. Because for too many families, it's not just an extra few cents per egg. It's another crack in the fragile foundation they're trying to stand on.


